What you can expect at The Heatons...

We are open **Monday-Friday 8am-6pm** 50 weeks of the year closing the week between Christmas and New Year and the last week of the school summer holidays. We offer full day or half day sessions.

- A **full day** session is **8am-6pm**.
- The **morning** session is **8am-1pm**.
- The **afternoon** session is **1pm-6pm**.

We are a 75 place Day Nursery and Preschool, small enough to take a uniquely personalised approach to providing **high quality care and learning opportunities**.

Our **4 rooms** are **specially designed to create age-appropriate environments**, with activities tailored to the unique requirements of each age group.

Our team are very experienced working with young children and each room has an **experienced room leader** who takes responsibility for ensuring both you and your child have a fantastic experience with us.

The building operates to the highest standards of security and all staff are First Aid trained. We have **CCTV** in all our rooms to give you **full peace of mind**.

We are passionate about **nutritious, home cooked food** prepared daily by our cook, and we cater for all dietary needs. We offer breakfast, a hot two course meal for lunch and a light tea in the afternoon. Babies will of course be given milk at times directed by you.

Your child will benefit from a **stimulating outdoor play areas** which we will make use of all year round. Outdoor play is essential in children's development and provides so many opportunities to explore and have fun.

We offer all sorts of **extra activities**, including Footy Tots, Tiny Talk baby sign, Baby Ballet and Rhythm and Rhyme, Jo Jingles, Spanish sessions and visits to the local Care Home, all of which are included within the cost of your nursery place.

We use an **online learning journal** called Tapestry to take observations of your child's development and daily activities. This can be accessed by parents with photos or videos to give you a sneak preview of all the fun your child is having here with us.

We have a **car park** situated at the side of our building for you to drop off and pick up your child. Alternatively, we have several secure pram stores around the building for you to leave your prams, bikes and scooters throughout the day.

Our Rooms:

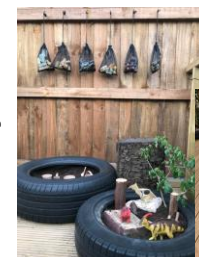
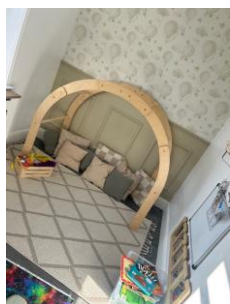
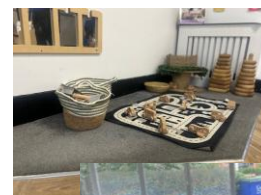
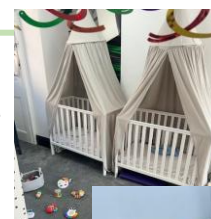
Moor Room: The Moor Room is our baby room. Our babies are cared for by an experienced team in a very homely environment. There are several areas for the babies to explore and investigate. There is a Cosy Corner, Home Corner, a Physical Area, Exploration and a messy play area. The children in our baby room also have access to their own baby garden. Our focus is on the unique child, and we work closely with you to best follow their individual needs and routines.

Mersey Room: Our Mersey room is our toddler room. Split over two rooms our younger and older toddler rooms are a hive of activity and fun, challenging your children in a happy, safe and stimulating environment. There are lots of areas and activities which will develop your child's imagination, communication and physical skills and staff offer so much praise and encouragement which will ensure that the children believe in themselves and continually feel a sense of achievement.

Chapel Room: The Chapel room provides a rich, varied and safe space in which the children can play, explore and learn. Their enabling environment ensures that children grow and develop to be resilient, capable, confident and self-assured. The children have a range of areas to explore including a home corner, construction area and a messy play area for sand, playdough and creative tasks. Our experienced team plan fun, engaging activities for both child initiated and adult led activities to support their development.

Norris Room: Norris room is our preschool room and is run by a strong team of qualified and enthusiastic early years practitioners, including a qualified teacher, who deliver a well-planned routine which is bursting with fun and excitement. We nurture children's learning and development within the Early Years Foundation Stage Curriculum through a range of teacher led input, child-initiated learning through play and extra activities such as Footy-Totz, Baby Ballet and Rhythm and Rhyme.

Outdoor Area and Forest School: Our engaging outdoor areas provide children with an array of opportunities to develop their physical skills, self-esteem and confidence supporting their overall health and wellbeing. Our outdoor area brings the indoor provisions outside with a well equipped Mud Kitchen, role-play area, cosy book corner as well as a range of gross and fine motor activities.

Additional activities:

Footytotz: Footytotz delivers a structured early years play programme for children up to five years old. It is designed to develop children's motor skills, balance, coordination & agility whilst having fun!

Tiny Talk Baby Sign: This class teaches your child to communicate using British Sign Language (BSL) through hands on sensory activities and songs which develop their all-round communication skills such as vocalising, listening and taking turns.

Baby Ballet: This session provides a calming physical activity for our younger children to get involved with, practicing core and leg strength whilst building on their listening skills and following instructions.

Rhythm & Rhyme: These energetic and engaging multi-sensory sessions are specifically designed to target child development using songs, puppets, bubbles, parachutes and more.

Jo Jingles - This class offers fun, interactive music, singing and movement classes. Support your child to express themselves through rhythm, instrument and song form.
